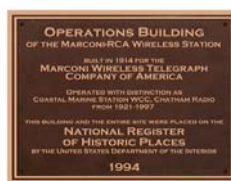

In 2006, the Chatham Marconi Maritime Center presented two bronze plaques to Chatham Selectmen and the Historical Commission on behalf of the Town. The Chatham Historical Commission has installed the two bronze plaques on the Radio Operations Building and the adjacent Hotel. The inscriptions commemorate the placing of Marconi/RCA buildings and site on the National Register of Historic Places by the U.S. Department of the Interior in 1994. 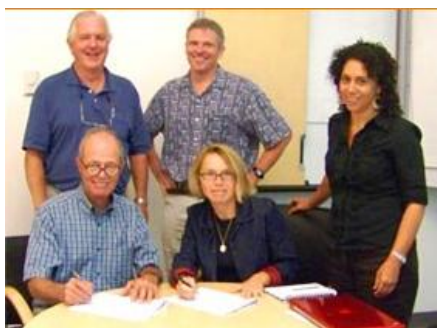
